Motion:

Jacobus Petrus van der Merwe (candidate for President) proposes a rebrand to become a broader pop music society. The constitutional amendments include:

1. Changing the society's name from Bristol SU Taylor Swift Appreciation Society to **Bristol SU Pop Music Society** (abbreviated **BPM Soc**) or a similar name subject to SU approval.
2. Changing current aim #1 from "Creating a space safe for all members to share their love for Taylor Swift's music, build a community to go to Swiftoggedon events together" into "**Creating a safe space for all members to share their love for pop music from different artists, including but not limited to Taylor Swift, and build a community to go to pop music events together such as Swiftoggedon and concert films**"
3. Changing current aim #2 from "Creating a community based on our shared love of Taylor Swift's music and to theorise future music that she will release" into "**Creating a community based on our shared love of different pop artists' music, including but not limited to Taylor Swift, and to theorise future music that they will release**"

The society will maintain its core Taylor content (hence the "including but not limited to Taylor Swift" clause) but then also engage wider pop music interests.
