Motion: *Remove the Colston Dolphin from the University Crest and Stop Selling Merchandise Featuring It*

Amendment proposed:

To amend the proposed motion in the following ways:

- Original Action:

1. For officers of the SU to lobby the University to pursue steps to remove the dolphin from its crest.

- Amended Action:

1. For officers of the SU to lobby the University to access the possibility and conditions of removing the dolphin from its crest, and to publicise a report on the issue after discussing the topic with the University.

- Original Action:

3. For the SU to cease the sale of all products featuring the Colston dolphin on its store and develop new designs in its stead that can represent all Bristol students.

- Amended Action:

3. For the SU to reduce the sale of all products featuring the Colston dolphin on its store and develop new designs in its stead that can represent the wider community of Bristol Students, while retaining different designs of the products for choices for customers.

- Original Action:

4. For the SU to commit itself to not using any imagery depicting the dolphin in any capacity and to not use any racist imagery.

- Amended Action:

4. For the SU to commit itself to not using any imagery depicting the Colston dolphin individually and to not use any imagery embracing racism.

To add the following action to the motion:

5. For officers of the SU to lobby the University to reveal the breakdown of money used in changing the university's logo in February this year, and the person(s) who designed the new logo, as a follow-up on the university's logo-changing process.
