This is a zero-hour contract with a guaranteed six hours per week, plus opportunities to increase hours during key campaigns.

You'll need to be able to work a minimum of four hours per week in person with the Marketing Team in our Senate House offices.

You'll work closely with the Marketing Team and Full-Time Officers to create content, support platform management, and produce paid-partnership posts with local and national businesses. We're looking for someone confident both behind and in front of the camera, with great communication skills and a genuine passion for social media.
